Planning is now well underway for the staging of the **66th Annual Yeppoon Show**, and as you are a valued supporter, we would like to again invite you and your school/childcare centre to take part in our **Education Display**.

The theme this year is '**Sustainability in Agriculture**', the practice of farming using principles of **ecology**. The study of relationships between plant and animal production and the environment that will last over the long term to; satisfy human food and fibre needs; sustain the economic viability of farm operations; enhance environmental quality and the natural resource base; make the most efficient use of non-renewable resources and on-farm resources; integrate natural biological cycles and controls; and enhance the quality of life for farmers and society as a whole.

In addition to your display, we also invite you to participate in our '**Growers Wheelbarrow Challenge**', for which your students are encouraged to plant fruits, vegetable or flowers in a wheelbarrow to be presented for judging at this year's show. Understanding that as a community gardening offers many benefits and teaches children valuable life skills, such as *Responsibility* - teaching importance of responsibility sets them in good stead for many aspects of their life.... *Creativity* - gardening stimulates children's imaginations and encourages them to exercise their creativity.... *Nutrition, Health and Fitness*.... *Discovery*... and *Self Confidence*. As well as learning about; food production, the environment, biodiversity of species and the importance of populations of pollinators (insects, birds and mammals), and the great importance of sustainability in agriculture.

In 2021 we have another exciting addition to the show that is bound to be popular for children in the **Lego Competition**, that you may like to promote. *For more details on how to enter the Lego competition and other sections please see the website.*

TERMS and CONDITIONS

1. SIZE OF DISPLAY:

Standard available space along a wall is 2.1m high x 2.5m wide x 1m deep.

** Corner sites may vary in size depending on content of display.*

** Free standing space may be available in the middle of the building if preferred.*

Every effort will be made to allow suitable space for each display, and to accommodate exhibitors preferred sites.

2. DISPLAY OPTIONS:

One 2m folding table and upright art display stands will be available if required. All sites have walls or A frame stands that provide a backdrop that allows for artwork to be displayed.

3. SECURITY:

A Show Steward will be on site at intervals throughout the day, and on ground Security will be present at night. The pavilion will be closed and locked from 6pm Saturday night.

If extra security is deemed necessary by the school or centre, they will need to provide their own.

4. SET UP & PULL DOWN:

Displays can be **SET -UP** between **9am & 11am; or 3pm & 5pm on Friday June 4, 2021**
